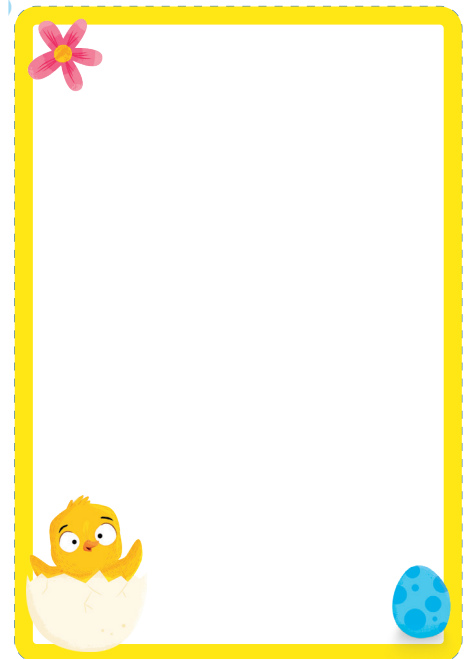
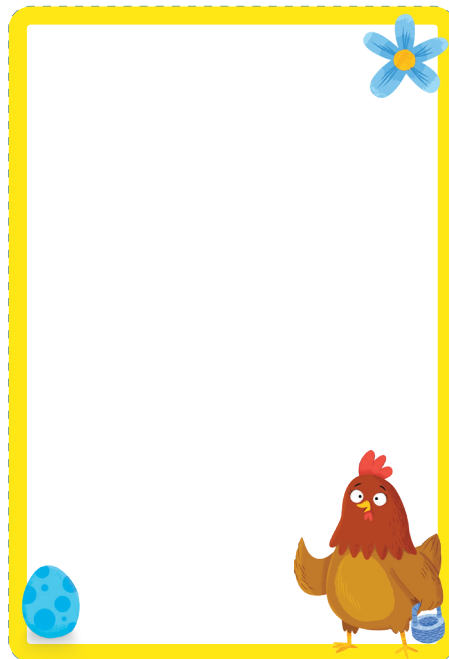
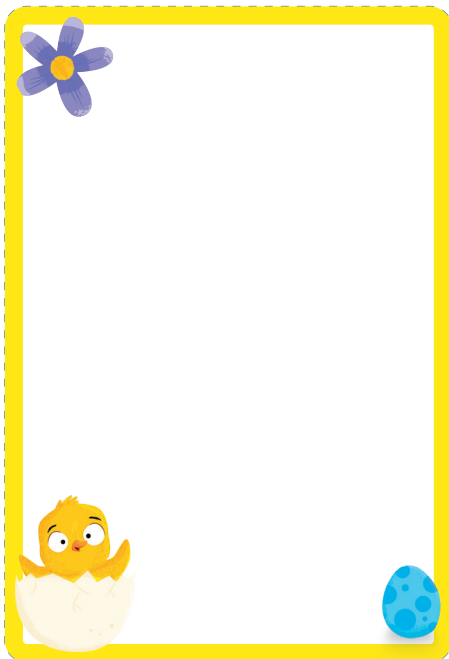
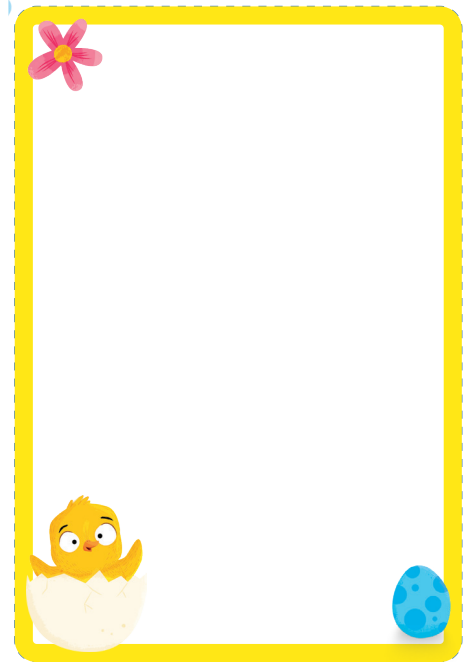
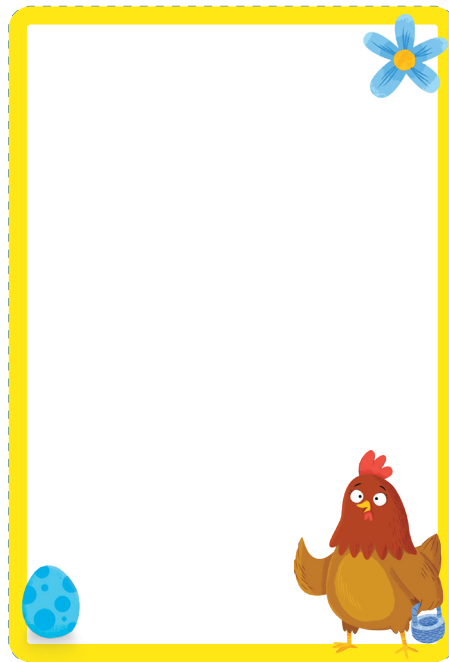
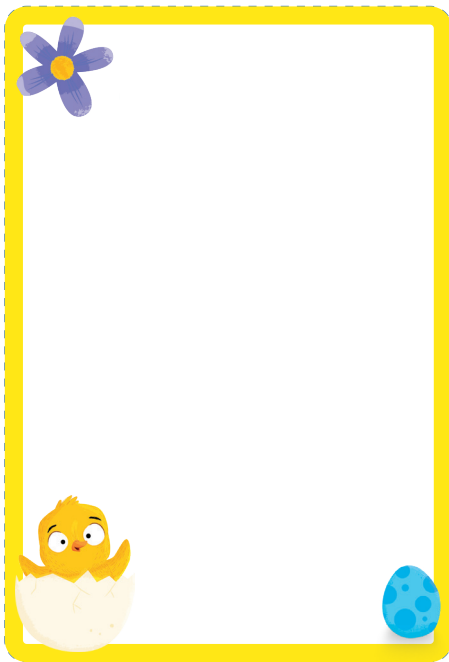


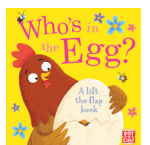


CREATE YOUR OWN Indoor Easter Egg Hunt

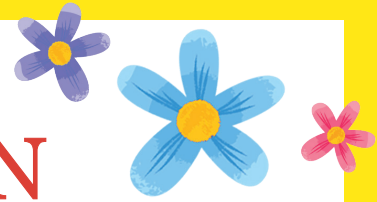

Top tip: if you have kids of different ages why not write anagrams for the older kids or draw pictures for the littlest ones.

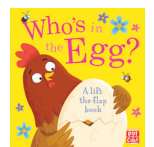
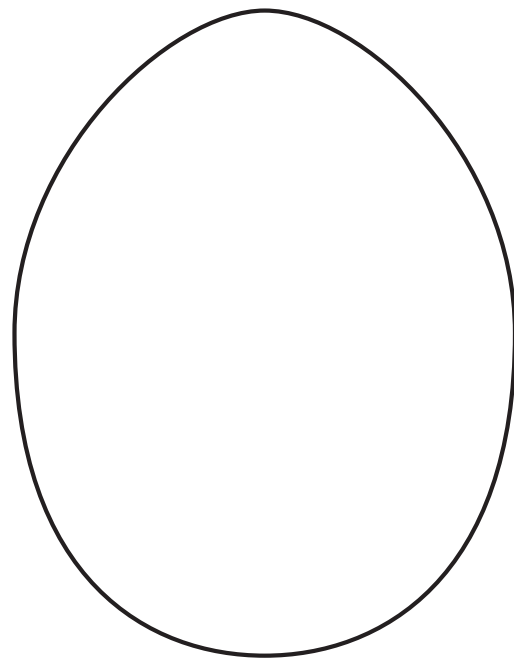
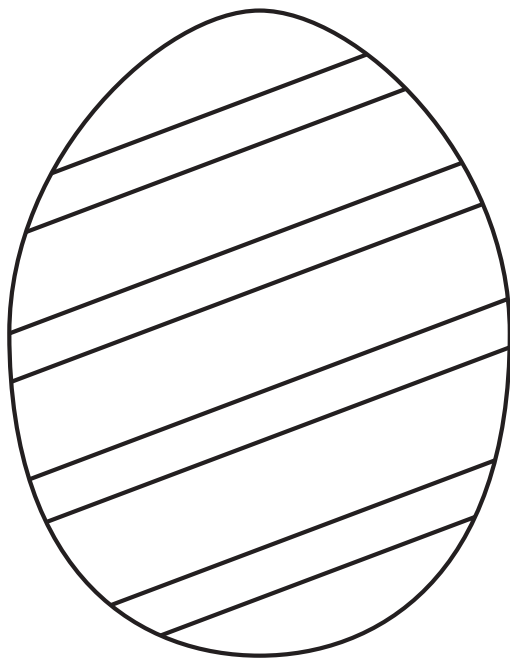
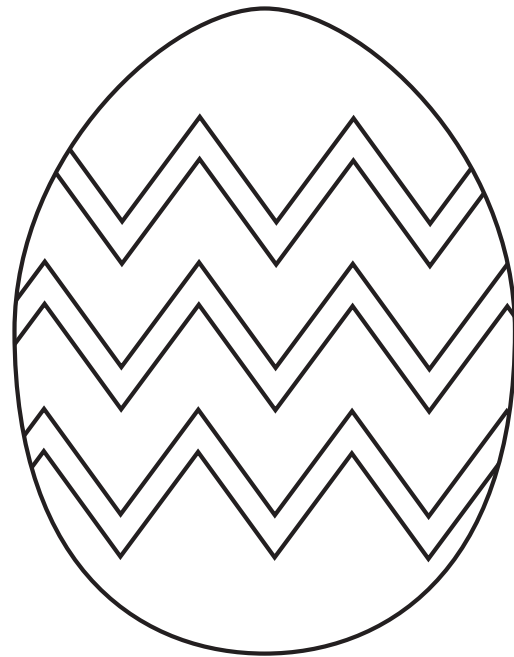
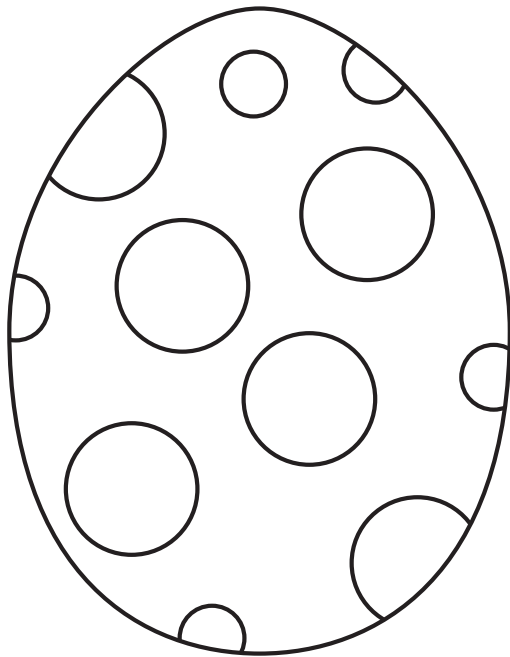
